As you know, Mum died last year, and her funeral took place with just 4 of us, standing outside the crematorium in Cheltenham for 15 minutes. It was a bit grim, to be honest. Now that lockdown restrictions have been eased, we are planning to take Mum's ashes for interment in St Andrew's church, Eastern Green, where my Dad's ashes are also laid. We have spoken to the church and are having a small ceremony at the graveside on 10 July, at 2pm, which will last about 15 minutes. We would like to let you know in case you wanted to join us: we have hired the room at the back of the church and provided that the roadmap out of lockdown proceeds as expected, we will be able to have a cup of tea and some cake in there (and use the loo!) afterwards.

We are keen that anyone who knew Mum and wants to be there knows about this so that they can be made welcome. Please do let others know if you think they would like to come. Once her ashes have been laid to rest there will be a headstone at the same place as Dad's in the cremation part of the churchyard.
